Benjamin Oreskes covers state and national politics for the Los Angeles Times. He graduated from Northwestern's Medill School of Journalism in 2015. In 2021, the Los Angeles Press Club named him print journalist of the year honoring "his on-theground reporting of various homelessness issues during the pandemic." In 2023, Oreskes and his colleagues won the Pulitzer Prize for breaking news.



Andre M. Perry is a Senior Fellow at Brookings Metro, a scholar-in-residence at American University, and a professor of practice of economics at Washington University. A nationally known and respected commentator on race, structural inequality, and education, Perry is the author of the book "Know Your Price: Valuing Black Lives and Property in America's Black Cities."
